We are looking forward to running our annual Summer School here at Maghull High School which will begin on Monday 17 August 2026 – Friday 21 August 2026. Our Summer School is hugely popular thanks to a range of exciting activities put on throughout the week which allows students to form new friendships, get to know our school and learn new hobbies and skills. Summer School is open to all students in year 6 who will be joining us in September 2026. Summer School will operate from 9am-3pm throughout the week of 17 August and students can opt to attend as many of the five days as they like. **All students will need to bring their own packed lunch and snacks each day.** Please note that Maghull High School is a nut free school so all products must be free from nuts. The final day of our Summer School week, Friday 21 August, provides an opportunity for parents and carers to join us for a showcase afternoon where we celebrate all that students have achieved throughout their week. Our final day will include a DJ, inflatable course and a visit from our local ice-cream van!

Our Summer School programme will be available to book from 2 March (induction day) and a more detailed timetable will be provided to all students and families on our induction day/evening on 25 June 2026. Summer School costs £15 per day and is payable via ParentPay. We aim to set up ParentPay for all new students and families within the summer term. **Until this has been set up, no payment will be required.** We will give you more information about ParentPay on our induction evening in June.
