Dear Parents and Carers

Choosing a secondary school for your child is a very important decision and we are proud and delighted that you have chosen Maghull High School, an oversubscribed and popular school. We very much look forward to welcoming you and your child to our school community and will write to you over the coming weeks with further information and guidance. Our aim over the coming months is to provide a supportive transition process to make sure they are happy, feel safe, cared for and make new friends quickly.



Your child will be one of many joining Maghull High School from a number of different primary schools. Some children find the transition from primary school easy, others will be less confident, but all of them will find both the older students and the staff very helpful in enabling them to adjust to new and much larger surroundings. In general, you will be surprised how quickly your child will 'find their feet'.

Education is a partnership between the home and the school. It is important that staff and parents work together, with our young students, to ensure the delivery of a quality education. We work hard to ensure that we always act in the best interest of each individual child.

In year seven, much attention is paid to identifying the needs of each student and providing appropriate educational guidance. From the start, all children are expected to respect each other, respect property and respect themselves. They are encouraged to take pride in their achievements as well as in their appearance and uniform. They are also encouraged to participate fully in the life of the school, for the benefit of others, as well as themselves. Please impress upon your child that success at school depends on how hard they are prepared to work. We expect all children to do their best, complete homework thoroughly and make worthwhile contributions to the wider life of the school.

Over the coming months key teaching and support staff will visit your child at their primary school to introduce themselves and address any questions or concerns your child may have. We also run an annual summer school for our new year seven students. These events take place to ensure the transition to secondary school is both enjoyable and as smooth as possible. Our planned induction day is Thursday 26 June, when your child will spend a full day with us here and you will be invited to attend a parent evening.
