Dear Parents and Carers

I am pleased to enclose some further information regarding the transition of your child to Maghull High School.

I hope you find the information helpful. Additionally, I would also ask yourself and your child to read and sign the home school agreement. This can either be sent back to us or simply brought into school by your child when they start. All of this information is also available on the Transition page of our school website alongside copies of our prospectus and the current bus timetable.

We are looking forward to meeting your child in their primary school when we visit them over the coming months as well as welcoming them to their induction day here on Thursday 26 June. They should attend Maghull High School on that day, in their normal primary school uniform; the day will start at 8.50am and end at 3.20pm. During the day, they will be given a tour of the school, will attend an assembly and some lessons and will have the opportunity to ask any questions they may have about their new school. They may wish to take advantage of our regular school bus services on that day or can be dropped off in the vicinity of school; in either case, all children should enter the site via the Gainsborough Avenue entrance, where they will be welcomed by staff.

Children can either bring a packed lunch for the day or may wish to sample our school meals. For the sum of £4, your child can have meal of the day, as well as a drink and refreshments at break. Although we operate a cashless catering system, your child will be able to pay cash on the day. If your child is entitled to a free school meal, please indicate this on the form below and we will make the necessary arrangements.

On the evening of 26 June, at 6.00pm, parents are invited to attend to meet their child's form tutor and other key staff. There will be a display of school uniform and an opportunity to purchase items after the meeting with your child's form tutor. Senior members of staff will be available should you wish to talk about your child's future at Maghull High School. In addition to this induction evening, our SENDCO will be hosting an information evening for parents and carers of students who have additional learning needs so that there is an opportunity to meet our Inclusion team, and learn how we support students at Maghull High School. This will take place on Wednesday 14 May between 5pm-6pm.

We will be running our highly popular, annual summer school which will commence week beginning Monday 18 August. More details regarding summer school can be found on our website via our Transition page.
