Hello and welcome to this week's edition of our school newsletter. Thank you to all parents and carers who attended this week's year 13 Parents Evening. This week, students in year 9 attended our GCSE Options Fair to help support them in making informed choices ahead of their GCSEs next year. Students also visited Liverpool Hope University this week to explore life within Higher Education, whilst students in year 7 enjoyed a STEM Theatre in Education Roadshow.

GCSE Options Fair

This week, all students in year 9 attended our GCSE Options Fair where they got to meet and speak to individual subject areas to gather further information about their subject option choices and pathways for next year. Each subject set up their own stall to showcase their GCSE subject content and exam specification requirements, helping to support students in making informed choices when it comes to choosing their option subjects for GCSE. In addition to our GCSE Options Fair, all students in year 9 will have 1-1 meetings with their form tutor, or a member of the Senior Leadership Team to discuss their options pathway. We will also be hosting a face-to-face Parents Evening for all year 9 students and families on Thursday 5 February to provide additional guidance for parents and carers to help support in students' options choices.
