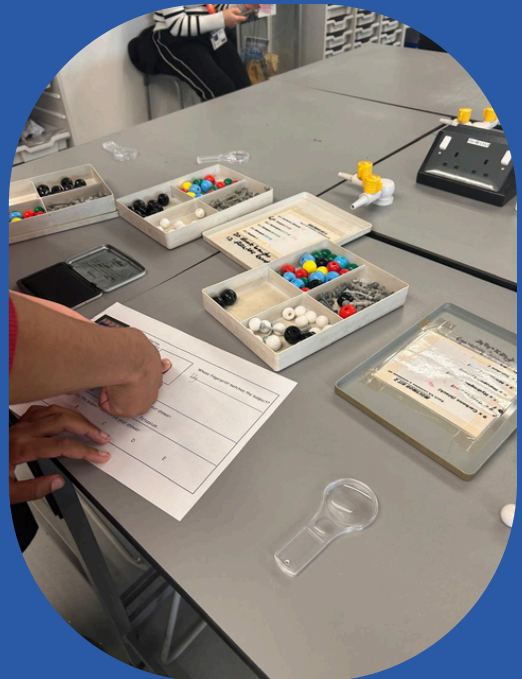
Introducing our London Mini-Marathon Runners...

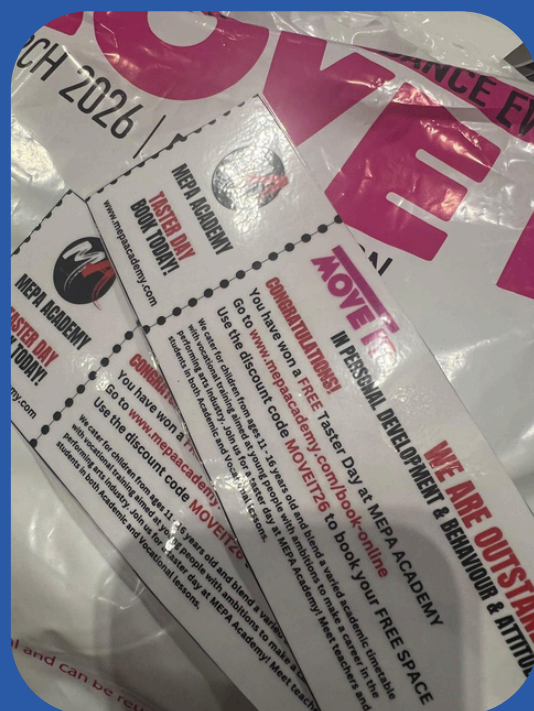


MOVE IT!
